In addition:

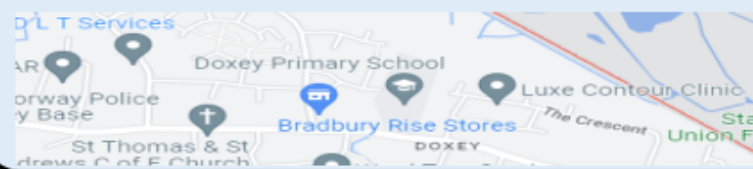
- Spellings/handwriting will be practised regularly.

- Write a story.



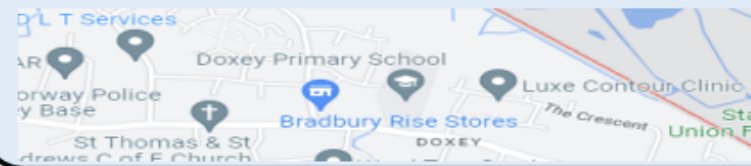
In addition:
