Sparkles



Sparkles is situated at the front of the school in a well equipped, bright and stimulating room. It is a self-contained unit with a large outdoor area. The children have free flow access to the indoor and outdoor environments throughout the session.

Sparkles is run by Miss Bacon, a experienced Early Years Practitioner, who works with Miss Thomson and Mrs Garbett to provide an enriched curriculum for the children.

Sessions are available for 2-3 year olds, every morning from 8.45am and every afternoon from 12.15pm or children can stay for a full day. The Sparkles staff open the gate at 8.40am to welcome the children into Sparkles.

Additional childcare sessions can be booked at the school office, using the booking form enclosed in your Welcome pack. They are bookable on a monthly or weekly basis.

The 30 hour funded sessions run from 11.45am-2.45pm an additional Top Up session can be booked from 2.45pm-3.15pm at an additional cost of £2.50 per day.

Children staying for the lunch will need to bring a packed lunch and drink. Milk, water and fruit are provided for every child during the morning session.
