Welcome to the Early Years Foundation Stage at Doxey Primary School.

Our Nursery



Our Nursery is situated at the front of the school in a well equipped, bright and stimulating classroom. The Nursery is a self-contained unit with a classroom and large outdoor area. The children have free flow access to the indoor and outdoor environments throughout the session.

The Nursery is run by Mrs Monaghan, a qualified teacher, who works with the Nursery staff to provide an enriched curriculum for the children in their class.

The 15 hour funded sessions, available to all 3-4 year olds, run every morning from 8.45am - 11.45am. The Nursery staff will open the gate at 8.40am to welcome the children into Nursery.

If you would like extended childcare hours, we are able to offer lunchtime and afternoon sessions and 30 hour funded places*. Before and Afternoon school club is also available and is bookable from the school office.

Additional Childcare:

Additional childcare sessions can be booked at the school office, using the booking form enclosed in your Welcome pack. They are bookable on a monthly or weekly basis.
