- Identify and describe key geographical features of Great Britain.
- Identify and locate some counties of Great Britain.
- Locate and identify rural and urban areas including; some towns and major cities in Great Britain.
- Find out about the hills and mountains of Great Britain and how they were formed.
- Find out about the seas and coasts around Great Britain and rivers within our country.
- Identify major landmarks around Great
 Britain and understand their significance.

In Computing, we will;

- Learn about E-safety
- Research famous landmarks in Britain and present our information

In PE, we will;

be learning how to play Invasion Games and we'll be using different techniques for passing, controlling, dribbling and shooting the ball in games.

In English we will use the text 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna to:
