Sports clubs during lunch-time and after-school 3 days per week	£6975.00	Uptake in sports significantly increased. Prior to use of sport coaches, no clubs took place at lunch-time or after school. More children are playing sports at lunch-time when no club is taking place; evidence that the pupils enjoy the activities and are keen to continue in their own time. Clubs include: KS1 multi-sports, football, netball, cheerleading, KS2 multi-sports.

FA Primary Teachers Football Coaching Qualification Four teachers to undertake qualification during the Autumn and Spring terms. Six-week course. Coach alongside the FA Coach & complete gap tasks.	£1000.00	Improved subject knowledge for four teachers / HLTAs. Sustainability. Excellent football coaching for four classes over six weeks.
Young voices dance workshop. Cannon Hill MAC centre, Birmingham. Four staff attended training. Dance (& singing) club lunch-times & after school.	£240.00 (training) £200.00

Doxey employs sports coaches to deliver sports lessons during the school day (not paid for by Sports Premium). The coaches assess pupils on a wide variety of skills during the year and track progress to measure the impact of teaching. At least 'Good' progress has been made by all pupils, this may be due to the introduction of structured, regular sports teaching.
