

Our Stars of the Week

YEAR 5 & 6 visit The Big Bang Fair at the N.E.C— Friday 15th March 2019

The purpose of this trip is to consolidate and enrich the Science topics we have already covered in class this year - Forces, Earth and Space and Properties and Changes of Materials. The Fair gives young people the chance to try out over 100 hands-on activities, see dozens of mind-boggling shows, hear from inspiring engineers and scientists from some of the UK's biggest companies and find out about the opportunities available in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Maths). The trip has been heavily subsidised by the school fund however for children to visit to the NEC a payment of £10.00 is requested either in cash or cheque.

YEAR 5 Visit Stafford Fire Station – Tuesday 19th March 2019

Year 5 have been invited to Stafford Fire Station to take part in Safe & Sound Workshops. The workshops are designed to support our community to make informed and positive choices improving their health, safety and wellbeing. All children will take part in workshops on: Fire Safety, Trucks and Child Safety, Anti Social Behaviour, What to do in an Emergency, Water Safety and Railway Safety. For children to visit the workshops at the fire station, a payment of £5.00 is requested either in cash or cheque.

YEAR 3 & 4 visit Conkers—Thursday 21st March 2019

To coincide with Year 3 and Year 4 learning about the Stone Age. We have arranged a trip to Conkers. The children will take part in a Stone Age workshop and will: meet a tribe member, discuss the beliefs of people from the Stone and Bronze Age, explore compare and contrast the difference in lifestyle between hunter gatherers and early farmers and they will learn how our ancestors developed the tools to hunt and survive. The trip has been heavily subsidised by the school fund however for children to visit Conkers and take part in this amazing experience a payment of £10.00 is requested either in cash or cheque.
