YEAR 6—LEVEL 2 BIKEABILITY COURSE - Monday 10th and Tuesday 11th May

Bikeability is cycle training for the 21st century, designed to give the next generation the skills and confidence to ride their bikes on today's roads. Together with Staffordshire County Council we are able to offer Level 2 training, of what is being recognised as the country's leading cycle training provision, to student's school age Year 5+.

The majority of training will take place within school time and will be provided by experienced instructors over multiple days. The Level 2 training provides cyclists with a comprehensive knowledge of on-road cycling including positioning on-road, signalling, negotiating a variety of junctions and general road awareness. Staffordshire County Council strongly recommends that a correctly fitted cycle helmet should be worn by all pupils participating in Bikeability training.

Letters with permission slips were sent home last week. Permission slips need to be returned to school by Tuesday 27th April.

NEW AFTERSCHOOL ENRICHMENT CLUBS
