The school will be hosting a range of afterschool activities starting today. Some sessions are free of charge and some sessions are chargeable. The clubs will run until week ending Friday 28th May.

### YEAR 6—LEVEL 2 BIKEABILITY COURSE - Monday 10th and Tuesday 11th May

Bikeability is cycle training for the 21<sup>st</sup> century, designed to give the next generation the skills and confidence to ride their bikes on today's roads. Together with Staffordshire County Council we are able to offer Level 2 training, of what is being recognised as the country's leading cycle training provision, to student's school age Year 5+.

The majority of training will take place within school time and will be provided by experienced instructors over multiple days. The Level 2 training provides cyclists with a comprehensive knowledge of on-road cycling including positioning on-road, signalling, negotiating a variety of junctions and general road awareness. Staffordshire County Council strongly recommends that a correctly fitted cycle helmet should be worn by all pupils participating in Bikeability training.
