Holiday's during term time can only be approved if there are exceptional circumstances. Leave of absence forms must be submitted to Mrs Wynn for approval prior to leave being taken. Please be aware that if your request for leave of absence is not approved and you still take your child out of school, the leave is recorded as unauthorised, which may be subject to a Penalty Notice fine of **£60 Per parents per child**. This fine will increase to £120 if not paid within 21 days. Failure to pay the £120 fine within the period 22 to 28 days may lead to court proceedings.
