Attendance

As a school we have a responsibility to inform parents of their child's attendance. Parents have a legal responsibility to ensure regular school attendance which is deemed to be around 95%.

If a child's attendance falls below this percentage we have a responsibility to work with families to improve attend-

We are monitored by the Local Authority and have to show we are monitoring school attendance and taking action where needed.

Holidays taken in term time can result in a Penalty Notice Fine.

Penalty Notice Fine:

£60 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days rising to £120 per parent per child if paid between 21-28 days.

If the fine is not paid within 28 days you may be prosecuted under S444.1 of the Education Act 1996. I must advise that if the prosecution takes place, the maximum fine is £1000 per parent, per child. This reflects the seriousness of unauthorised absence from school.

If you have any concerns regarding attendance please do not hesitate to contact the school to discuss this further. We want to work with you to prevent your child missing valuable education.
