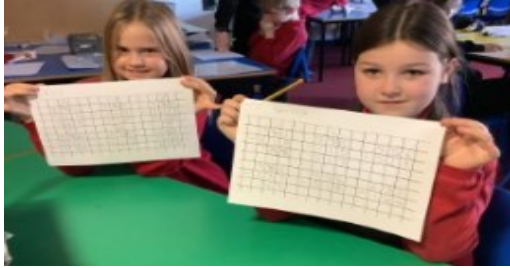


# The Doxey Digest

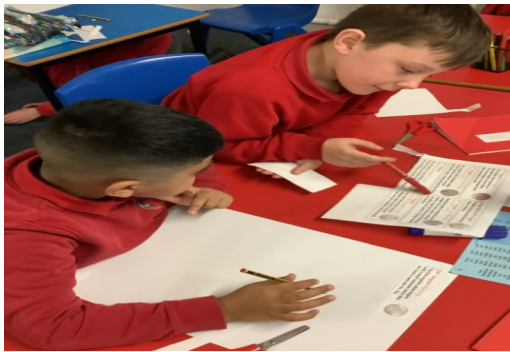

Year 3 have been working on addition and subtraction. They have just advanced from a place value grid to using the column method.



Reception enjoyed 'Welly Wednesday' this week by observing the changes that are happening outside with the weather getting colder and exploring the frost. They also enjoyed finding shapes that are in the environment.

Year 4 are working towards writing a newspaper report about the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79AD. To ensure they write in chronological order, they sequenced the timeline of the eruption, looking carefully at times and dates.
